#### ART. 1 – SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- UniTO students who are not resident in Italy are not allowed to study at a University of their own Country
- The Ministry of Foreign Affairs can discourage any dangerous student mobility. In specific dangerous circumstances UniTO can interrupt, modify or cancel the Student Mobility.

#### ART. 2 – PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

✓ To be duly enrolled at the University of Turin (UniTO) a.y. 2020/2021



- ✓ UG course (max possibility: 12 months abroad)
- ✓ PG course (max possibility: 12 months abroad)
- ✓ Any student with a previous Erasmus experience.
   Determinant to have enough months left (UG or PG)










#### ART. 3 – STUDYING PERIOD

- ✓ Minimum 3 months (90 days) max 12 months
- ✓ Bilateral Agreement confirming the stay (4 or 5, 8, 9 months)
- ✓ Ongoing Student Mobility from June 2020 to September 2021
- ✓ Possible extention (after arriving abroad)
- ➤ UG students 1<sup>st</sup> year: departure in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year (only 1<sup>st</sup> sem.)
- ➤ UG students 2<sup>nd</sup> year: departure in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- ➤ PG students 1<sup>st</sup> year: departure in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year (only 1<sup>st</sup> sem.)









#### ART. 4 – ALLOWED AND NOT ALLOWED ACTIVITIES





#### YES

- ✓ Studying (attendance and exams)
- ✓ Dissertation research
- ✓ Studying + internship (no overlap admitted) with the Host University approval

#### NO!

- ✓ Taking or registering for UniTO exams
- ✓ Graduating at UniTO

#### **WARNING!**

Any UniTO exams and/or graduation will be cancelled.







#### ART. 5 – ACADEMIC RECOGNITION

- ✓ Learning Agreement (to be agreed with the two Universities)
- ✓ Consistency between the courses chosen in the Host University and the courses not attended at the Home University (disciplinary area)

#### Art. 7.2 - SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT

#### First instalment

➤ Before September 2020 (100% **A**)+ (70% **B** according to the economic requirement)

#### Second instalment

> 30% **B** 

#### Waiver / The student has to return the entire amount received if:

- the student renounces to the Erasmus experience
- the student stays less than 90 days abroad

#### The student has to return part of the amount received if:

- > the student stays less than the period agreed by the Bilateral Agreement
- > the credits recognised by UniTO are less than 2 EU credits per month
- ➤ the credits recognised by UniTO are less than 1 EU credit for dissertation research

FG: final grade 43 (113-70) where 113 represents the highest mark degree and 70 the lowest mark degree







FINAL SCORE (A1+B): max 65 points 1<sup>st</sup> year UG FINAL SCORE (A+B): max 100 points 2<sup>nd</sup> year UG and 1<sup>st</sup> year PG

#### **Registration exams:**

First year before January 31st, 2020 Second year before October 31st, 2019







## Winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> ranking:

Students will be ranked from the highest to the lowest depending on their scores and considering – if possible – the destinations they choose.

Students who do not win a place will be given a reserved position on the list.

## **Eligible student:**

After the acceptance or waiver the eligible applicant will be assigned to the destination of their choice, if available.







## **Eligible students for the 2<sup>nd</sup> ranking:**

Applicant meet the call requirements, but due to the lack of places in the destination choices, the student will be assigned to the 2<sup>nd</sup> ranking. The Interuniversity office will assign students places taking into consideration their choice of linguistic area.
