

**GENERAL SUMMARY OF THE
REGULATIONS FOR THE ADMISSION TO THE MASTER’S DEGREE PROGRAMS IN
AMMINISTRAZIONE E CONTROLLO AZIENDALE (ACA), BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (BA,
English-medium), DIREZIONE D’IMPRESA MARKETING E STRATEGIA (DIMS), FINANZA
AZIENDALE E MERCATI FINANZIARI (FAMF) AND PROFESSIONI CONTABILI (PC)**

This document is a general summary of the Regulations, highlighting the main points and deadlines. Please refer to the official text of the Regulations for detailed information.

LIMITED NUMBER OF PLACES

For the 2021-2022 academic year, the Master’s Degree programs in *Amministrazione e Controllo Aziendale (ACA)*, *Business Administration (BA – English-medium)*, *Direzione d’Impresa Marketing e Strategia (DIMS)*, *Finanza Aziendale e Mercati Finanziari (FAMF)* and *Professioni Contabili (PC)* will have a **capped number of places**. The maximum number of students that can be admitted to the first year of each Master’s Degree program is the following:

CURRICULAR AND PERSONAL PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet two requirements in order to enroll in the aforementioned Master’s courses:

1. A **curricular requirement**, which is met for **graduates or graduands** of the following Bachelor’s Degrees:
 - Ex. DM 270/2004: Bachelor’s Degree courses belonging to L-01 to L-43, to class L/DC (*Scienze della Difesa e della Sicurezza*) and class LMG1 (*Laurea in Giurisprudenza a ciclo unico*)
 - Ex. DM 509/1999: all Bachelor’s Degree classes from 1 to 42, and DS1 class (*Scienze della Difesa e della Sicurezza*)

The curricular requirement of applicants with a qualification belonging to other Degree program classes shall be evaluated by the Admission Requirements Commission of the Department.

2. A **personal preparation requirement**, which will be assessed in the admission test. This will result in the rankings, as described in the Regulations. The adequate personal preparation requirement is met **with a minimum score of 15/100 or higher**. The rankings will be based on the test score.

Below is a brief summary of the regulations which apply to **“Italian candidates; EU candidates and equivalents; non-EU candidates legally residing in Italy”** and to **“Chinese candidates in the Marco Polo Project”**. For the regulations applying to **“non-EU candidates residing abroad”** please refer to section 6.1 of the Regulations.

ADMISSION TEST SESSIONS: ADMINISTRATION AND NUMBER OF AVAILABLE PLACES

Two independent sessions of the admission test will be held, each with two separate rankings. The candidate can register to both sessions, in the event that he/she has failed to enrol in the first one. Both sessions will be held remotely, to ensure equal treatment.

LANGUAGE

The admission test will be the same for all the Master's Degree programs mentioned in the Regulations and it will be in Italian, with the exception of some thematic questions in English. The only exception is Business Administration, whose admission test will be in English.

In the second session, those applicants selecting Business Administration among their two options will have to sit the test in English.

TEST COMPOSITION, TEST DURATION, SYLLABUS AND MINIMUM SCORE

In the Italian version of the test, 5 questions will be in English. In the English version of the test, all questions will be exclusively in English.

The test will last 60 minutes and will consist of 50 multiple choice questions, with only one correct answer out of four answer options.

The [Syllabus](#) included in the Regulations describes the test program and lists the bibliographic references.

The requirement of adequate personal preparation is met **with a minimum score of 15/100 or higher**. The rankings will be based on the test score.
